A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of State from issuing a passport, passport card, or Consular Report of Birth Abroad that includes the unspecified (X) gender designation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Passport Sanity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION REGARDING CERTAIN GENDER DES-**
2 **IGNATION ON PASSPORTS, PASSPORT CARDS,**
3 **AND CONSULAR REPORTS OF BIRTH ABROAD**
4 **ISSUED BY DEPARTMENT OF STATE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State shall—

6 (1) ensure each application for a covered docu-
7 ment includes only the gender designations male and
8 female; and

9 (2) prohibit the issuing of a covered document
10 that includes the unspecified (X) gender designation.

11 (b) COVERED DOCUMENT DEFINED.—In this section,
12 the term “covered document” means a passport, passport
13 card, or Consular Report of Birth Abroad issued by the
14 Department of State.
